27 grandchildren, Amanda Griffin and Allen Griffin; four sisters,

2 Griffin; and two brothers, Henry Griffin and Bill Griffin; and

3 WHEREAS, in addition to his parents, he was preceded
4 in death by three sisters, Estell, Inez, and Hazel; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Griffin was a valued member of the
6 community; although his presence will be missed, his memory
7 will be cherished in the hearts and minds of those who were
