7 the induction of Jearl Miles-Clark into the National Track and  
8 Field Hall of Fame; and

9 WHEREAS, she is a 1989 graduate of Alabama A and M  
10 University, where she was motivated to pursue her dreams and  
11 try out for the Olympics; and

12 WHEREAS, she is a world-acclaimed athlete whose  
13 career is recognized for excellence and longevity, highlighted  
14 by winning six Gold Medals over a period of two decades; and

15 WHEREAS, she has achieved success in both 400-meter  
16 and 800-meter races, and holds the American record with a time  
17 of 1:56.40 in the 800-meter; and

18 WHEREAS, her numerous titles include the 1993 World  
19 Outdoor Championship, along with additional Gold, Silver, and  
20 Bronze Medals in World Championships and Olympic Games from  
21 1991-2003; and

22 WHEREAS, she took special pride in being a member of  
23 the relay team that won the Gold Medal in 1996 when the  
24 Olympics were in Atlanta, an achievement repeated in the 2000  
25 Olympics in Sydney, Australia; and

1               WHEREAS, Jearl Miles-Clark's election to the  
2       National Track and Field Hall of Fame is the source of  
3       justifiable pride to Alabama A and M University and to sports  
4       fans throughout the State of Alabama; through the years, she  
5       has combined athletic prowess with a willingness to work  
6       diligently in pursuit of excellence, and she is truly  
7       deserving of this significant honor; now therefore,

8               BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
9       HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Jearl Miles-Clark is honored  
10      and commended for her outstanding record of athletic  
11      achievement and, by copy of this resolution, we extend  
12      heartiest congratulations to her on being inducted into the  
13      National Track and Field Hall of Fame along with best wishes  
14      for success in all future endeavors.
