3 MOURNING THE DEATH OF DR. LEWIS HALL MCCURDY, JR.

5 WHEREAS, with an overwhelming sense of loss, we
6 receive news of the death of Dr. Lewis Hall McCurdy, Jr., of
7 Brownsboro, Alabama, on February 28, 2011, at the age of 61
8 years; and

9 WHEREAS, the death of Dr. McCurdy leaves a void in
10 the lives of his loving family, his many friends, and the
11 entire community, where he was well-known and highly regarded
12 as a longtime veterinarian and civic leader; and

13 WHEREAS, the son of the late Lewis and Beulah
14 McCurdy of Lowndesboro, he graduated from the Lowndes Academy
15 in 1968 and attended Auburn University, receiving his
16 Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine Degree upon completing a
17 preceptorship in Daphne in 1974, after which he moved with his
18 family to Huntsville; in 1980, he opened McCurdy Animal
19 Hospital and continued to practice until the time of his
20 death; through the years, he saved the lives of countless pets
21 as well as homeless animals; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. McCurdy served the community at both
23 the state and local levels in many organizations including:
24 the Board of Directors of the Greater Huntsville Humane
25 Society, the Board of Directors of the Animal Emergency Clinic

1 of North Alabama, the Vestry of the Church of the Nativity,
2 the Board of Directors of the Burritt Museum, and the Madison
3 County Veterinary Association, serving as president and in
4 other capacities; and

5 WHEREAS, he also held numerous offices in the
6 Alabama Veterinary Association, including the presidency, and
7 was honored with the award of Alabama Veterinarian of the Year
8 in 2007 in addition to the prestigious Service Award for
9 Lifetime Achievement; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. McCurdy was also the founder and
11 charter president of the Alabama Veterinary Medical
12 Foundation, and he was instrumental in starting the low-cost
13 Spay/Neuter License Plate Program, with proceeds from the sale
14 of automobile tags going to low-income families to help with
15 their pets; and

16 WHEREAS, he is survived by his devoted wife, Nancy
17 Pate McCurdy; two children, Elizabeth (John) Koisch and Dr.
18 Lewis Hall (Eleanor) McCurdy, III; five grandchildren, Lewis
19 Hall McCurdy, IV, John Joseph Koisch, III, Lewis Alexander
20 Koisch, Eliza Pate McCurdy, and Grayson Anne McCurdy;
21 brothers, Billy (Pam) McCurdy and David McCurdy;
22 brother-in-law, Bubba (Lindsay) Pate and Mitchell (Beth) Pate;
23 and many additional beloved family members; and

24 WHEREAS, Dr. McCurdy loved people and was passionate
25 about his profession; although his presence will be missed,

1 his legacy will endure and his memory will be cherished in the
2 hearts and minds of those who were fortunate to know him; now
3 therefore,

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
5 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the death of Dr. Lewis Hall
6 McCurdy, Jr., is recorded with deep sadness, and this
7 resolution is offered in highest tribute to his life, along
8 with heartfelt sympathy to his grieving family.
