12 are herein conveyed to Coach Gene Chizik of the Auburn Tigers
13 Football program, who does us great honor with his presence in
14 the Alabama House of Representatives on this momentous

7 unblemished record of 13 victories and 0 defeats, earning the
8 Southeastern Conference Championship and capping the season
9 with a spectacular victory in the BCS National Championship
10 Game in Glendale, Arizona; and

11 WHEREAS, it is an honor and a privilege to recognize
12 this extraordinary Alabamian for his contributions to Auburn
13 University and to our State; now therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
15 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we hereby commend and
16 congratulate Coach Gene Chizik of Auburn University on his
