8 COMMENDING WALDON TUCKER UPON HIS INDUCTION INTO THE
9 2011 ALABAMA HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS HALL OF FAME.

11 WHEREAS, it is with immense pride and pleasure that
12 we recognize Waldon Tucker upon his induction into the 2011
13 Alabama High School Sports Hall of Fame, which recognizes
14 athletics as an integral and extremely important part of
15 learning teamwork, discipline, and good sportsmanship; and

16 WHEREAS, among the prominent individuals selected
17 for induction into the 21st class of the Alabama High School
18 Sports Hall of Fame is Coach Tucker, a native of Linden,
19 Alabama, a graduate of the University of West Alabama, who
20 played on the 1971 Livingston University NAIA National
21 Championship team; and

22 WHEREAS, Coach Tucker, who is the football coach at
23 Fayette County High School, became the state's all-time
24 winningest prep football coach last season; his overall record
25 through his quarterfinal playoff elimination loss is
26 309-126-3; of those, 284 wins are in the Alabama High School
27 Athletic Association; and

1 WHEREAS, Coach Tucker was named Class 2A Coach of
2 the Year at Gordo in 1980 after a 13-0 state championship run;
3 he was named 5A Coach of the Year in 1989, and 4A Coach of the
4 Year in 1996; and

5 WHEREAS, coaching at Fayette County since 1984,
6 Coach Tucker guided the 1996 team to a 15-0 season and the
7 Class 4A title; and

8 WHEREAS, in addition to football, Coach Tucker also
9 served as a Fayette City Councilman for eight years; and

10 WHEREAS, indeed, Coach Tucker is an exemplar of
11 extraordinary leadership ability and significant achievement,
12 who is entirely deserving of induction into the 2011 Alabama
13 High School Sports Hall of Fame; now therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
15 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That in recognition and gratitude
16 for outstanding contributions to athletics, and upon his
17 induction into the 2011 Alabama High School Sports Hall of
18 Fame, we hereby most highly honor Waldon Tucker to whom a copy
19 of this resolution is provided with tribute and esteem.
