COMMENDING DR. NATALIE A. WHALEN UPON HER SELECTION  
AS MS. WHEELCHAIR ALABAMA 2011.

WHEREAS, it is with great pleasure that we recognize  
Dr. Natalie A. Whalen of Ozark, Alabama, upon her selection as  
Ms. Wheelchair Alabama 2011; and

WHEREAS, she was selected as the state's most  
accomplished and articulate spokesperson for those who utilize  
wheelchairs for mobility, and she will represent the State of  
Alabama during the Ms. Wheelchair USA competition in July 2011  
in Green, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Whalen is a highly esteemed educator  
who retired in 2005 after a distinguished career; she  
graduated from Florida State University in 1982 with a  
Master's Degree in Special Education, minoring in History, and  
earned her Doctor of Philosophy Degree in Special Education  
from The Union Institute and University of Cincinnati, Ohio,  
in 1999; and

WHEREAS, at the age of five, she was left paralyzed  
from the shoulders down when struck by a truck; she was not

1 expected to recover, a diagnosis that her devoted mother  
2 adamantly refused to accept; gradually some of the paralysis  
3 dissipated and for many years she astounded doctors by walking  
4 with the aid of crutches and braces, which she managed to  
5 continue until she was about 24 years old; she also succeeded  
6 in proving wrong the medical opinion that she would not be  
7 able to bear children; Dr. Whalen is the proud mother of two  
8 as well as the doting grandmother of six and great-grandmother  
9 of one; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. Whalen's platform for Ms. Wheelchair  
11 Alabama and Ms. Wheelchair USA is "It's All a Matter of  
12 Attitude"; she loves to travel and has driven all over the  
13 country, often taking along a grandchild; among her roles of  
14 community leadership, she is an officer of the Wiregrass  
15 Patriots, Secretary of the Claybank Master Gardeners, and  
16 Queen Mother of the Bama Belles, Red Hat Society; and

17 WHEREAS, through the years and in all her endeavors,  
18 Dr. Whalen has earned respect for her determination and  
19 exceptional abilities, and she is truly deserving of this  
20 significant honor; now therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
22 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby most heartily  
23 commend and congratulate Dr. Natalie A. Whalen as Ms.
