8 MOURNING THE DEATH OF MR. TENNICE F. MCCLENDON.

10 WHEREAS, with profound sorrow and regret, we receive
11 news of the death of Mr. Tennice F. McClendon of Guntersville,
12 Alabama, on December 30, 2010, at the age of 84 years; and

13 WHEREAS, the passing of Mr. McClendon leaves a void
14 in the lives of his loving family, his many friends, and the
15 entire community, where he was well-known and highly regarded;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. McClendon served his country with honor
18 and distinction for 20 years, having joined the United States
19 Navy in 1943; after serving in the Pacific Theater during
20 World War II, he transferred to the Air Force and saw action
21 in the Korean War; he later became a Marine Policeman for the
22 State of Alabama and served for 24 years, all but two of them
23 on Guntersville Lake; and

24 WHEREAS; among his roles of civic leadership, he
25 served multiple terms on the Guntersville Board of
26 Adjustments; he was a longtime member and president of the
27 local chapter of Ducks Unlimited, a potentate's aide in the

1 Cahaba Shrine Temple, and president of the Marshall Shrine
2 Club; and

3 WHEREAS, he is survived by his wife, Belle
4 McClendon; two sons, Mark (Pam) McClendon and Jon McClendon;
5 daughter, Rothe (Michael) Simpson; two brothers, Charlie
6 (Mary) McClendon and Tommy (Linda) McClendon; and two sisters,
7 Ruth (Arthur) Saylor and Janice Hyatt; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. McClendon was a valued member of the
9 community; although his presence will be missed, his memory
10 will be cherished in the hearts and minds of those who were
11 fortunate to know him; now therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
13 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the death of Mr. Tennice F.
14 McClendon is recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution
15 is offered in tribute to his life, along with heartfelt
