WHEREAS, millions more are injured or made ill; and

WHEREAS, concerned Americans are determined to prevent these tragedies by observing Workers Memorial Day on April 28, 2011, as a day to remember these victims of workplace injuries and disease by renewing our efforts to seek stronger safety and health protections, better standards and enforcement, and fair and just compensation, and by rededicating ourselves to improving safety and health in every workplace; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That April 28, 2011, be declared Workers Memorial Day in the State of Alabama, in recognition of workers killed, injured, and disabled on the job.
