URGING STATE AGENCIES, STATE DEPARTMENTS, AND PUBLIC ENTITIES TO COMPLY WITH SECTION 29-1-25, CODE OF ALABAMA 1975, BY DISTRIBUTING MATERIAL TO MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE VIA THE INTERNET.

WHEREAS, for the fiscal year 2009-2010 the state spent approximately 1.3 million dollars for copy paper; and

WHEREAS, given the economic condition of the state, online distribution of reports and documents is encouraged and will result in significant savings for the state; and

WHEREAS, Section 29-1-25, Code of Alabama 1975, allows a legislator to request and promptly receive a paper copy of any material; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Legislature urges all state agencies, state departments, and public entities to implement a cost-saving measure by complying with Section 29-1-25, Code of Alabama 1975, by distributing publications to members of the Legislature via the Internet.
