13 WHEREAS, for the fiscal year 2009-2010 the state
14 spent approximately 1.3 million dollars for copy paper; and

15 WHEREAS, given the economic condition of the state,
16 online distribution of reports and documents is encouraged and
17 will result in significant savings for the state; and

18 WHEREAS, Section 29-1-25, Code of Alabama 1975,
19 allows a legislator to request and promptly receive a paper
20 copy of any material; now therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
22 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Legislature urges all
23 state agencies, state departments, and public entities to
24 implement a cost-saving measure by complying with Section
25 29-1-25, Code of Alabama 1975, by distributing publications to
26 members of the Legislature via the Internet.
