11 received of the death of Simon David Boozer of Anniston,
12 Alabama, on April 11, 2011, at the age of 75 years; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Boozer was born to David Leon and Ruby
14 Kyle Boozer, on January 12, 1936, in Anniston, Alabama; he
15 graduated from Anniston High School and received a Bachelor of
16 Architecture degree from Washington University of St. Louis,
17 Missouri; and

18 WHEREAS, he served in the United States Army and
19 Reserves prior to establishing his practice in Anniston as S.
20 David Boozer, AIA Architect, PC; he retired in 1996 after 30
21 years of practice; he was a member of the Alabama
22 Architectural Foundation and the American Institute of
23 Architects; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Boozer was a member of the First United
25 Methodist Church of Anniston where he served on the Board of
26 Stewards; he was a Master Mason, a member of the Scottish
27 Rite, past president of the Anniston Rotary Club, long time

1 board member of the Knox Concert Series, served on the
2 Salvation Army Board and the YMCA Board; he was vice president
3 of the Anniston Chamber of Commerce, a member of Leadership
4 Calhoun County, chair of Youth Leadership Calhoun County, and
5 served in the International Executive Service Corps; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Boozer was preceded in death by his
7 parents and his sister, Margaret van der Blom; he is survived
8 by his wife, Patricia Foster Boozer; daughter, Margaret Ann
9 Boozer-Strother; grandson, Kyle Misuel Boozer-Strother; son,
10 David Edward (Leslie) Boozer; granddaughters, Lauren Elizabeth
11 Boozer, Kaitlyn Alysa Boozer; Megan Christine Boozer;
12 step-daughter, Kristi Michelle Key; stepson, Foster Douglas
13 (Tina) Key; stepgrandsons, Trenton Foster Key, Austin Tyler
14 Key, and Nicolas Colton Key; nephew, David Isbrand (Tanya)
15 Vanderblom; nieces, Meg Dierke Vanderblom and Dina Wilhemina
