12 Emergency as a result of the devastating tornado outbreak in
13 Alabama on April 27, 2011; and

14 WHEREAS, Governor Bentley mobilized approximately
15 1,400 Alabama National Guardsmen and numerous state agencies
16 to provide emergency assistance to the Alabama counties
17 impacted by the severe weather outbreak; and

18 WHEREAS, Governor Bentley activated the Governor's
19 Recovery Response Center in the State Capitol as a central
20 resource to help citizens obtain the information and resources
21 they needed in the aftermath of the storm; and

22 WHEREAS, Governor Bentley established the Governor's
23 Emergency Relief Fund to help Alabamians with unmet recovery
24 needs that continue to unfold; and

25 WHEREAS, Governor Bentley and his staff worked
26 tirelessly around the clock to assist the citizens of this
27 state adversely affected by the tornadoes; and

1 WHEREAS, Governor Bentley and his staff have
2 coordinated the work of the countless state employees under
3 the direction of his cabinet who continue to provide public
4 safety and human services to the survivors of the storm; and

5 WHEREAS, Governor Bentley and his staff's swift and
6 competent response has been a beacon of light in the sea of
7 this disaster, giving hope to survivors of this unprecedented
8 storm; now therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
10 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Governor Robert Bentley and
11 staff are honored and commended for demonstrating exceptional
12 leadership in the wake of the tornado outbreak that struck the
13 state on April 27, 2011.

16 colleague, Governor Robert Bentley, with admiration and
