19 Marines, Navy, and Air Force JROTC Units were represented,
20 these exceptional cadets took second place, capturing the
21 Silver Medal; and

23 Junior National Air Rifle Championships the team took first
24 place and the Gold Medal, accomplishing their second national
25 championship of the year; and

5 2011, team member Mikaelah Atchley earned three Gold Medals,
6 one at the Interservice Air Rifle Championships, one at the
7 Army Marksmanship Unit Junior National Air Rifle
8 Championships, and again at the NRA State Championships; and

9 WHEREAS, exceptional leadership was provided by LTC
10 (ret.) Ralph Aaron and CW4 (ret.) Joe Guthrie; and

11 WHEREAS, these fine young cadets indeed bring great
12 honor to themselves, their school, and community and, along
13 with their coaches, are deserving of highest praise for their
14 dedicated efforts and accomplishments; now therefore,
