11 WHEREAS, it is a pleasure to extend highest  
12 commendation to Jerry Wilkins in recognition and appreciation  
13 of his outstanding record of achievement and dedicated service  
14 to the Tuscaloosa Baptist Association; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Wilkins announced his retirement in  
16 April 2011, having served as Director of Missions for the  
17 Tuscaloosa Baptist Association for almost 27 years; and

18 WHEREAS, a graduate of Samford University and  
19 Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, he was called into  
20 the ministry in 1966 while attending Temple Baptist Church in  
21 Tuscaloosa; and

22 WHEREAS, he served as pastor of several churches in  
23 Texas while in seminary before becoming pastor of Valley View  
24 Baptist Church in Leeds, Alabama; and

25 WHEREAS, while serving as pastor of Oakwood Baptist  
26 Church in Chattanooga, Tennessee, he was contacted by the

1 Tuscaloosa Baptist Association about becoming Director of  
2 Missions; and

3                   WHEREAS, under his leadership, the association has  
4 grown from 59 to 87 churches, built a new resource center, and  
5 established the Christian Ministry Center, the Good Samaritan  
6 Free Medical Clinic, the Neighborhood Missions Ministry, and a  
7 disaster relief program; and

8                   WHEREAS, he and his wife of 45 years, Carole, who  
9 recently retired from biblical lay counseling, continue to  
10 reside in Northport and are members of Lakewood Baptist  
11 Church; and

12                  WHEREAS, his plans for retirement include finishing  
13 the most recent of the books he has written, "A Practical  
14 Guide to Associational Missions," and being available for  
15 interim pastorates and helping churches as a conflict  
16 resolution consultant; in addition, he has been named Director  
17 of Missions Emeritus, a testimony to the esteem in which he is  
18 held; now therefore,
