12 herein extended to a remarkable Alabamian, Raymond Navarro
13 Glover, on the occasion of celebrating his 90th birthday; and

14 WHEREAS, born August 4, 1920, he is the son of Tom
15 and Aroler Glover, the youngest of 19 children; after
16 attending the private and public schools of Anniston, Alabama,
17 he graduated from Morris Brown College in Atlanta, Georgia,
18 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Glover is a proud veteran of World War
20 II, stationed in India, China, and Burma, and attaining the
21 rank of Supply Sergeant in the United States Army,
22 Quartermaster Corps 1945; and

23 WHEREAS, an esteemed educator and civic servant, he
24 taught high school social studies in Talladega, Cleburne, and
25 Calhoun Counties for 18 years; he was the first Black
26 professional to serve in the Calhoun County Juvenile Court

1 System as a Probation Officer, retiring from the court system
2 in 1982; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Glover was ordained as a Deacon of
4 Seventeenth Street Baptist Church in 1989 and is a lifetime
5 member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated; and

6 WHEREAS, in his 90th year, he continues to be a
7 source of inspiration to those who are fortunate to know him;
8 now therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
10 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Raymond Navarro Glover is
11 honored and commended, and this resolution is offered with
12 heartiest congratulations to him on celebrating the milestone
13 of his 90th birthday, along with best wishes for every future
14 happiness.
