3 RECOGNIZING ALABAMA WOUNDED WARRIORS AND REQUESTING
4 THE STATE TO WAIVE CERTAIN RECREATIONAL FEES FOR WOUNDED
5 WARRIORS.

7 WHEREAS, the State of Alabama wishes to express its
8 appreciation for the sacrifices of all American servicemen and
9 servicewomen and, especially the sacrifices of America's and
10 Alabama's Wounded Warriors; and

11 WHEREAS, the State of Alabama welcomes all Alabama
12 wounded warriors and urges all state agencies to make
13 available all recreational parks, facilities, and resources
14 Alabama offers free of charge to wounded warriors; and

15 WHEREAS, Alabama welcomes all out-of-state wounded
16 warriors who have the sponsorship of a not-for-profit veterans
17 organization or who are sponsored by a military organization
18 (active, reserve, or National Guard) to hunt and fish within
19 the boundaries of the State of Alabama and state officials are
20 urged to provide full free access to all State of Alabama
21 parks and recreational areas; now therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
23 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we recognize all of America's
24 and Alabama's Wounded Warriors and urge the state officials
25 and departments to provide free access to state recreational

1 areas, parks, and hunting and fishing access to wounded
2 warriors.
