8 COMMENDING TAD MOORE FOR HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE  
9 GAME OF GOLF.

11 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we honor the  
12 contributions of Tad Moore for his contributions to the game  
13 of golf; and

14 WHEREAS, a resident of Selma, Alabama, Mr. Moore has  
15 been designing exceptional custom golf clubs for both amateur  
16 and professional golfers since 1963; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Moore is recognized as one of today's  
18 premier club designers, with his golf club designs recognized  
19 by their classic and timeless shape; and

20 WHEREAS, an accomplished amateur golfer, Mr. Moore  
21 has utilized his knowledge of the game to enhance his club  
22 designs; and

23 WHEREAS, Mr. Moore dedicated himself to full-time  
24 golf club design in 1989 when he signed an agreement with  
25 Dunlop/Maxfli/Slazenger Corporation, where he designed  
26 matchless clubs of the 1990s, including the Maxfli 100 percent  
27 milled putter, which was a first for the golf industry; and

1           WHEREAS, at one time, Mr. Moore had over 72  
2 distinguished golfers using his milled and cast putters, and  
3 in 1991, one of Mr. Moore's putters won the coveted Masters  
4 Tournament; and

5           WHEREAS, Mr. Moore designed the persimmon Maxfli  
6 drivers that continue to be used by professional and amateur  
7 golfers alike to boost their golf game, and many prestigious  
8 golfing events have been won with his wood clubs, including  
9 the PGA Championship; and

10           WHEREAS, promoting nostalgia, Mr. Moore introduced a  
11 line of hickory shafted golf clubs that are used for playing  
12 traditional golf and are similar to those designs of 1925  
13 MacGregor and William Gibson clubs, two of the most popular  
14 brands of that era; and

15           WHEREAS, in addition to his vast accomplishments and  
16 contributions to the game of golf, Mr. Moore designed and  
17 manufactured the shaft seals that were used on the axles of  
18 the Lunar Rover that landed on the Moon, further evidencing  
19 that he is a versatile designer indeed; now therefore,

20           BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF  
21 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Tad Moore is most highly  
22 commended for his immeasurable contributions to the game of  
23 golf, and that a copy of this resolution be provided to him as  
24 a symbol of our appreciation and best wishes for future  
25 success.
