7 herein extended to a remarkable Alabamian, Raymond Navarro
8 Glover, on the occasion of celebrating his 90th birthday; and

9 WHEREAS, born August 4, 1920, he is the son of Tom
10 and Aroler Glover, the youngest of 19 children; after
11 attending the private and public schools of Anniston, Alabama,
12 he graduated from Morris Brown College in Atlanta, Georgia,
13 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Glover is a proud veteran of World War
15 II, stationed in India, China, and Burma, and attaining the
16 rank of Supply Sergeant in the United States Army,
17 Quartermaster Corps 1945; and

18 WHEREAS, an esteemed educator and civic servant, he
19 taught high school social studies in Talladega, Cleburne, and
20 Calhoun Counties for 18 years; he was the first Black
21 professional to serve in the Calhoun County Juvenile Court
22 System as a Probation Officer, retiring from the court system
23 in 1982; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Glover was ordained as a Deacon of
2 Seventeenth Street Baptist Church in 1989 and is a lifetime
3 member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated; and

4 WHEREAS, in his 90th year, he continues to be a
5 source of inspiration to those who are fortunate to know him;
6 now therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
8 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Raymond Navarro Glover is
9 honored and commended, and this resolution is offered with
10 heartiest congratulations to him on celebrating the milestone
11 of his 90th birthday, along with best wishes for every future
12 happiness.
