3 COMMENDING TAD MOORE FOR HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE  
4 GAME OF GOLF.

6 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we honor the  
7 contributions of Tad Moore for his contributions to the game  
8 of golf; and

9 WHEREAS, a resident of Selma, Alabama, Mr. Moore has  
10 been designing exceptional custom golf clubs for both amateur  
11 and professional golfers since 1963; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Moore is recognized as one of today's  
13 premier club designers, with his golf club designs recognized  
14 by their classic and timeless shape; and

15 WHEREAS, an accomplished amateur golfer, Mr. Moore  
16 has utilized his knowledge of the game to enhance his club  
17 designs; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Moore dedicated himself to full-time  
19 golf club design in 1989 when he signed an agreement with  
20 Dunlop/Maxfli/Slazenger Corporation, where he designed  
21 matchless clubs of the 1990s, including the Maxfli 100 percent  
22 milled putter, which was a first for the golf industry; and

23 WHEREAS, at one time, Mr. Moore had over 72  
24 distinguished golfers using his milled and cast putters, and

1       in 1991, one of Mr. Moore's putters won the coveted Masters  
2       Tournament; and

3               WHEREAS, Mr. Moore designed the persimmon Maxfli  
4       drivers that continue to be used by professional and amateur  
5       golfers alike to boost their golf game, and many prestigious  
6       golfing events have been won with his wood clubs, including  
7       the PGA Championship; and

8               WHEREAS, promoting nostalgia, Mr. Moore introduced a  
9       line of hickory shafted golf clubs that are used for playing  
10      traditional golf and are similar to those designs of 1925  
11      MacGregor and William Gibson clubs, two of the most popular  
12      brands of that era; and

13               WHEREAS, in addition to his vast accomplishments and  
14      contributions to the game of golf, Mr. Moore designed and  
15      manufactured the shaft seals that were used on the axles of  
16      the Lunar Rover that landed on the Moon, further evidencing  
17      that he is a versatile designer indeed; now therefore,

18               BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
19      HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Tad Moore is most highly  
20      commended for his immeasurable contributions to the game of  
21      golf, and that a copy of this resolution be provided to him as  
22      a symbol of our appreciation and best wishes for future  
23      success.
