10 WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that Coach
11 Carol B. Chesnutt is recognized for her distinguished service
12 to education and the State of Alabama over the span of 33
13 years; and

14 WHEREAS, Coach Chesnutt has announced her retirement
15 from her position as Girls Athletic Director and Head Varsity
16 Volleyball Coach at Homewood High School, having served with
17 tireless dedication in public education as a math and physical
18 education teacher as well as a coach of various sports; much
19 of her exemplary career was spent in Hoover City Schools as a
20 volleyball and basketball coach; and

21 WHEREAS, a 1978 graduate of the University of
22 Montevallo, she earned her Master's Degree from the University
23 of Alabama at Birmingham in 1992; she is a longtime member of
24 the American Alliance for Health, Physical Education,
25 Recreation and Dance (AAHPERD) and has served as president of
26 the Alabama organization in many other capacities; and

1 WHEREAS, among her honors and recognitions, she
2 received the 1988 Secondary Physical Education Teacher of the
3 Year Award from the Alabama State Association for Health
4 (ASAHPERD), the Middle School Physical Education Teacher of
5 the Year Award in 1996 and the Southern District Middle School
6 Physical Teacher of the Year in 1997; in addition, she has
7 been recognized as the ASAHPERD Female Coach of the Year and
8 was selected by the Birmingham Sportswriters as the Metro
9 Coach of the Year for 2005; and

10 WHEREAS, her impact has been far-reaching and
11 immeasurable; many of the athletes she coached received
12 college scholarships and countless professionals, both inside
13 and outside the field of education, as well as student
14 athletes, owe a tremendous debt to Coach Chesnutt for the
15 outstanding example she set; and

16 WHEREAS, through the years, she has earned respect
17 for her exceptional abilities, selfless service, and
18 unwavering commitment to the ideals of public education and
19 athletics; now therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
21 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That in recognition of her
22 distinguished career, highest commendation is herein extended
23 to Coach Carol B. Chesnutt, for whom a copy of this resolution
