11 news of the death of Mr. Patrick Dewayne Harris on January 27,
12 2012, at the age of 38 years; and

13 WHEREAS, the untimely death of Mr. Harris leaves a
14 void in the lives of his loving family, his many friends, and
15 the entire community, where he was highly regarded; he was
16 employed with the Sumter County Board of Education for 12
17 years as the Chief School Financial Officer and was also a
18 civic leader; and

20 the late James Harris, Sr., and Juanita Evans Harris; he
21 joined First Baptist Church of Livingston at an early age and
22 later united with the Christian Chapel Baptist Church of

25 where he was an active member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity,
26 Incorporated, and served as undergraduate advisor of Mu Kappa
27 Chapter from 2001-2008; he also served as the fraternity's

1 state treasurer from 2006-2008 and was currently serving as
2 Membership Intake Process Coordinator for Central Alabama; and

5 wife, Tameka Harris; children, Patrick, Jr., Zaria, Kayla, and
6 Tammyra Harris; two sisters, Kimberly Harris and Jamie Harris;
7 seven brothers, James D. (Jackie) Harris, James Harris, Jr.,
8 Kenneth Evans, Walter Harris, Larry Smith, Tony Smith, and
9 Marvin Morris; stepmother, Theresa Harris; parents-in-law,
10 Reverend John H. and Dorothy Wright and Minnie Capers;
11 brothers- and sisters-in-law, Calvin Capers, Anita (Jeffrey)
12 Clarke, Carol Capers, and Helen and Patricia Wright; five
13 aunts; three uncles; special cousins who were loved as
