26 lived on Monte Sano in Huntsville and with much love,
27 enthusiasm, and dedication, she supported Fred's Army,

1 NASA-Marshall and UAH Research Institute careers; she
2 devotedly typed his book, article, and lecture manuscripts;
3 her husband's participation in the inception of the U.S. Space
4 and Rocket Center greatly delighted her; and

5 WHEREAS, with a beautiful smile always present on
6 her face, she had a warm, loving nature, easily made friends,
7 and was extremely close to her family; she enjoyed traveling
8 the world with Fred; an avid tennis player, she could hit a
9 powerful lob and loved to attend professional tennis
10 tournaments; and

11 WHEREAS, survivors include her beloved and devoted
12 husband Fred; their three children and spouses, Fred IV and
13 Lisa Ordway, Albert and Nancy Ordway, and Marisol and Bob
14 Lambert; cherished grandchildren, one sister, Beatriz de
15 Londono; and many adoring nieces and nephews; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Ordway was a valued member of the
17 community; although her presence will be greatly missed, her
18 memory will be cherished in the hearts and minds of those who
19 were fortunate to know her; now therefore,
