3 subdivision, the first in the area; he also owns and operates
4 two rental manufactured home parks and a used automobile sales
5 lot; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Nagy has served on the AMHA Board of
7 Directors for 14 years, holding the position of secretary in
8 1999-2000 and treasurer in 2001-2002, and has also been a
9 member of the Executive, Finance, Legislative, Convention,
10 Advertising, and Nominating Committees; and

11 WHEREAS, a devoted family man who is active in a
12 number of worthy causes, he and his wife, Michele, are the
13 proud parents of two sons, Jeremy and Ryan; Mr. Nagy has been
14 a member of the Enterprise Rotary Club for six years, serving
15 in key positions of leadership, and he was selected by the
16 Rotary Club to receive the Paul Harris Fellow Award for his
17 dedicated service to the community, including nine years as a
18 Boy Scout/Cub Scout leader; Mr. Nagy has also been a Charter
19 member of the Weevil City Cruisers, an antique car club, for
20 15 years; now therefore,
