DESIGNATING THE ALABAMA VETERANS CENTENNIAL MEMORIAL  
PARK IN ANNISTON, ALABAMA, AS THE SITE OF AN OFFICIAL MEMORIAL  
FOR VETERANS OF THE IRAQ WAR.

WHEREAS, located in Anniston, Alabama, is the Alabama Veterans Centennial Memorial Park; and within the park, bermed areas display the names of all Alabamians killed or missing from all wars of this century, which include World War I, World War II, Korean, and Desert Storm; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to honor and recognize the dedication and sacrifices made by the brave men and women who entered the United States Military and served in the Iraq war against terrorism; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that the park should become a site to serve as a symbol of gratitude to the men and women of this state who, as members of the United States Military, served in the Iraq war against terrorism; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Alabama Veterans Centennial Memorial Park in Anniston, Alabama, is designated as an Alabama Official Memorial for Veterans of the Iraq War.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be provided to the governing body of the City of Anniston for display at the sites of the memorial.
