12 21-0 victory over Louisiana State in the 2012 BCS National
13 Championship Game marked its 14th National Football
14 Championship; and

16 unanimously voted No. 1 in the Associated Press college
17 football poll, earning its eighth AP title; and

18 WHEREAS, the 14th championship was the 2nd BCS
19 championship for the Crimson Tide under the tenure of Head

21 modern era of college football to win a national football

25 performance and accomplishment in capturing the 2011 BCS
