2 ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,

3 DESIGNATING CERTAIN ROADS IN THE CITY OF MONTGOMERY
4 BY NUMBER AS A TRANSITIONAL TRAIL UNTIL THE OLD FEDERAL ROAD
5 ROUTE IS DESIGNATED AND DEVELOPED.

7 WHEREAS, Act 2007-414 of the 2007 Regular Session
8 created the Old Federal Road Task Force to determine whether
9 the Old Federal Road should be promoted as a historical trail;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, the task force is required to study all
12 aspects of how best to identify and promote the Old Federal
13 Road in the state; and

14 WHEREAS, the Old Federal Road Task Force desires to
15 submit a transitional route that most closely follows the Old
16 Federal Road in those counties within the state that the road
17 passed through, beginning in Russell County and continuing
18 through Mobile County by number until the Old Federal Road
19 route is designated and developed; now therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
21 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the transitional route of the
22 Old Federal Road as determined by the Alabama Department of
23 Transportation consists of all the following:

24 Montgomery County: Continue to follow US-80/AL-8
25 westward to Atlanta Highway; continue south to Madison Avenue;

continue by turning south on Decatur Street and head south to Norman Bridge Road or as an alternative route for this part due to existing one-way streets, in a northern direction, take Norman Bridge Road and head north on Union Street to Madison Avenue; continue south on Norman Bridge Road to Fairview Avenue; continue by turning west on Highway 31/Mobile Highway and continue south on Highway 31 to Pintlala.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this act supersedes Act 2008-370, HJR227 of the 2008 Regular Session (Acts 2008, p. 657).
