8 MOURNING THE DEATH OF MR. RALPH DOYLE FULMER, II.

10 WHEREAS, with profound sorrow and regret, we receive
11 news of the death of Mr. Ralph Doyle "Randy" Fulmer, II, on
12 March 25, 2012, at the age of 58 years; and

13 WHEREAS, the untimely death of Mr. Fulmer leaves a
14 void in the lives of his loving family, his many friends, and
15 the Alabama Supercomputer Authority Staff, where he served as
16 the Chief Executive Officer for the past 10 years; and

17 WHEREAS, born on December 8, 1953, he was the son of
18 Ralph D. Fulmer, CMSGT, USAF, Retired, and Betty J. Williams
19 Fulmer of Eclectic, Alabama; he was a 1972 graduate of Elmore
20 County High School and attended the University of Southern
21 Mississippi on a football scholarship; he later graduated from
22 Auburn University with a Bachelor of Science Degree and earned
23 a Master's Degree from Auburn Montgomery; and

24 WHEREAS, he was a longtime member of Frazer United
25 Methodist Church and an avid supporter of many charities,
26 especially the Montgomery and Elmore County Humane Societies
27 because of his love for animals; and

1 WHEREAS, he worked at BellSouth for 25 years before
2 beginning his career as the Chief Executive Officer of the
3 Alabama Supercomputer Authority to serve the citizens of
4 Alabama; and

5 WHEREAS, he worked tirelessly on behalf of the
6 people of Alabama, especially for the K12, postsecondary, and
7 higher education students; and

8 WHEREAS, he applied his skills and qualities of
9 organization, wisdom, fairness, knowledge, courage, and vision
10 in his duties and services to the State of Alabama; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Fulmer was a valued member of the
12 community, and we note with utmost admiration and appreciation
13 his distinguished service to the citizens of the State of
14 Alabama; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
16 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the death of Mr. Ralph Doyle
17 Fulmer, II, is recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution
18 is offered in highest tribute to his life, along with
19 heartfelt sympathy to his grieving family and colleagues.
