12              WHEREAS, highest commendation is herein conveyed to  
13 Nanette K. Pregno in recognition of her many years of  
14 dedicated service to the Legislature and the people of the  
15 State of Alabama; and

16              WHEREAS, among the notable highlights of her  
17 achievements, she deserves special praise for her unique  
18 ability to manage the Joe-Ron office suite, where she has been  
19 a commanding presence, providing exemplary service in  
20 presiding over the business and activities; in particular, she  
21 has managed to control and keep in line, insofar as possible,  
22 Joe Carothers and Ron Johnson, an unmanageable feat for the

17 the Alabama Building Commission and as a lobbyist for the  
18 United Transportation Union; she served as Administrative  
19 Director of the Alabama Consumer Finance Association and later  
20 Executive Director of the Alabama Wholesale Beer and Wine  
21 Association, before becoming one of the first female contract  
22 lobbyists in Alabama; and

23 WHEREAS, she is well-known in political circles for  
24 her holistic healing knowledge; her educational credentials  
25 include St. Vincent's Academy in Shreveport, Louisiana, and  
26 Louisiana State University, where she was a member of Delta  
27 Zeta Sorority; she is a HUGE fan of LSU, is known for her

1 fishing expertise, and is an outstanding Cajun cook whose  
2 judgment can be trusted on all things culinary; and

3 WHEREAS, among her additional qualities, she is  
4 known for her ability to juggle her busy schedule around "hair  
5 day" and all the animals she has to feed, including serving in  
6 the capacity of "yard wife," as the backyard neighbor, when  
7 the state's "High Sheriff" is out of town; and

8 WHEREAS, through the years, she has earned respect  
9 for her exceptional abilities and tireless dedication, and is
