8 Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, on the observance of
9 the 20th Annual Delta Day on Thursday, April 19, 2012, at the
10 Alabama State Capitol; and

11 WHEREAS, a sisterhood founded on January 13, 1913,
12 by 22 collegiate women at Howard University, Delta Sigma Theta
13 Sorority now has grown to a membership of more than 250,000
14 women, predominantly Black and college-educated, in more than
15 1,000 chapters throughout the United States and abroad; and

16 WHEREAS, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority follows a
17 national Five Point Program: Economic Development, Educational
18 Development, International Awareness and Involvement, Physical
19 and Mental Health, and Political Awareness and Involvement;
20 the sorority promotes academic excellence, provides

6 13, 2009, to serve as the United States Surgeon General, who
7 was unanimously confirmed by the United States Senate on

10 of Trustees of the Barry Goldwater Scholarship and Excellence
