24 University of Georgia, taught at Hinds Community College for

4 exceptional school that provides top tier education in a
5 Christ-centered environment; since the inception of the
6 National Merit Scholarship Program in 1983, the Southern
7 Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) accredited school
8 has had 95 National Merit Semi-Finalists and Finalists and 77
9 National Merit commended students; many Briarwood students
10 have earned scholarships over the years; Briarwood's boys and
11 girls athletic teams compete in 15 sports in the AHSAA; the
12 accomplished athletic teams have won 33 state championships
13 and numerous area, section, and regional championships and
14 runner-up honors; and

15 WHEREAS, Briarwood Christian School Student Mission
16 (BCSSM) has touched lives across the world with a powerful
17 ministry outreach, providing individuals in third world
18 countries with medical care, love, and encouragement through
19 ministry; through the program, educators have been encouraged,
20 affirmed, and provided professional training, and missionaries
21 have been supported, affirmed, and encouraged; the noble
22 Student Mission also provides construction support for
23 Christian churches and schools and has provided financial
24 support for student scholarships; and

2 widespread respect for his remarkable abilities and tireless
3 dedication; he has positively impacted the lives of countless
4 youth, and is truly deserving of this immense honor bestowed
