8 CONGRATULATING THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA WOMEN'S
9 GOLF TEAM ON WINNING THE 2012 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

11 WHEREAS, commendations and congratulations are
12 herein proudly conveyed to The University of Alabama's Women's
13 Golf Team on winning the 2012 National Collegiate Athletic
14 Association Championship; and

15 WHEREAS, in the NCAA finals on May 25, 2012, UA's
16 Crimson Tide golfers won by one stroke over the two-time
17 defending champions, the University of Southern California,
18 with Alabama finishing at six over 294 in the fourth round,
19 for a 19-over 1,171 total; and

20 WHEREAS, it was the first national title for Crimson
21 Tide Head Coach Mic Potter, and the first for UA's golf
22 program, in its seventh trip to the national tournament;
23 however, it was the third national sports title in 2012 for
24 Alabama, which also took top honors in football and women's
25 gymnastics; and

26 WHEREAS, the deciding moment came when senior Brooke
27 Pancake sank a four-foot putt for par on hole No. 18; other

1 team members who contributed significantly to the success of
2 the UA golf program are: Hannah Collier, Jennifer Kirby,
3 Daniela Lendl, Taylor Manning, Courtney McKim, Stephanie
4 Meadow, Jessica Schall, and Johanna Tillstrom; in addition to
5 the leadership of Head Coach Mic Potter, the team is guided by
6 Assistant Coach Susan Rosenstiel; and

7 WHEREAS, the outstanding accomplishments of the
8 talented student-athletes who are part of the UA Women's Golf
9 Team are the source of justifiable pride to their families,
10 their communities, and the entire State of Alabama; now
11 therefore.

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
13 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That The University of Alabama
14 Women's Golf Team is most highly honored and commended, and
15 its directed that a copy of this resolution be provided to the
