8 URGING CONGRESS TO PASS THE JOBS AND PREMIUM  
9 PROTECTION ACT.

11 WHEREAS, the Jobs and Premium Protection Act,  
12 introduced by Senator John Barrasso as Senate Bill 1880, would  
13 repeal provisions of the Patient Protection and Affordable  
14 Care Act which impose health insurance tax on each entity that  
15 provides health insurance for its employees; and

16 WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of Congress to  
17 effectively represent the citizens that elect them and to pass  
18 laws that provide real solutions rather than expanding the  
19 government's role in our lives; and

20 WHEREAS, the Jobs and Premium Protection Act repeals  
21 a proposed tax on entities that provide health insurance to  
22 their employees; and

23 WHEREAS, the citizens need reforms that lower costs,  
24 improve access, and strengthen the doctor-patient  
25 relationship; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the members of this body join in urging Congress to pass the Jobs and Premium Protection Act repealing the proposed tax on employees that provide health insurance to their employees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be made available to each member of the Alabama Congressional Delegation.
