11 WHEREAS, Multiple System Atrophy is a fatal  
12 neurological disease diagnosed in approximately 15,000  
13 patients in the United States; and

14 WHEREAS, as many as 35,000 more patients in the  
15 United States with Multiple System Atrophy are misdiagnosed  
16 with other more recognizable neurodegenerative disorders; and

17 WHEREAS, patients with Multiple System Atrophy lose  
18 the ability to walk, talk, chew, swallow, and even breathe  
19 over the course of a few years; and

20 WHEREAS, the incidence of Multiple System Atrophy in  
21 the United States has increased in recent years; and

22 WHEREAS, currently, there is no cure for Multiple  
23 System Atrophy; and

24 WHEREAS, the lack of awareness about Multiple System  
25 Atrophy has hindered research and the ability of researchers  
26 to obtain funding for their work; and

1               WHEREAS, public support and greater awareness of the  
2     need for research funding can aid in the discovery of the  
3     cause of and a cure for Multiple System Atrophy; now  
4     therefore,

5               BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
6     HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That March 2013 is recognized as  
7     National Multiple System Atrophy Awareness Month and, by copy  
8     of this resolution for appropriate display, we convey our  
9     commitment to the observance of this important annual endeavor  
10    in the battle against Multiple System Atrophy.
