9 AND COMMUNITY SERVICE.

11 WHEREAS, highest commendation is herein conveyed to
12 Audrey Kimbrough in recognition of saving the life of a heart
13 attack victim by immediately responding to the crisis and
14 providing competent assistance; and

15 WHEREAS, Audrey Kimbrough is the highly regarded
16 Regional Paramedical Service Operations Manager in Shelby
17 County but was off-duty when the emergency arose, just prior
18 to the beginning of a musical performance at Thompson Middle
19 School, when a middle-aged woman who had come to the event
20 became ill and fell onto the floor; and

21 WHEREAS, along with two other audience members,
22 Leann Brown and Robin Anderton, who are also health
23 professionals as emergency room nurses at Shelby Baptist
24 Medical Center, Audrey Kimbrough undertook the necessary
25 procedures to stabilize the victim until the arrival of the

1 Alabaster Fire Department Medical Team and an ambulance crew;

3 WHEREAS, as a result of the immediate response of
4 these competent women, motivated by humanitarian instincts and
5 guided by diligent training, the heart attack victim survived,
6 and witnesses to the event have marveled at the happenstance
7 that placed a "trio of angels" at the scene; and

8 WHEREAS, through the years and in all her endeavors,
9 Audrey Kimbrough has earned respect for her exceptional
10 abilities and tireless dedication, and she is truly deserving
11 of special recognition for her valiant, lifesaving actions on
12 the evening of February 14, 2013, at Thompson Middle School;
13 now therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
15 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Audrey Kimbrough is most
16 highly honored and commended for saving the life of a heart
17 attack victim, and it is directed that a copy of this
18 resolution of tribute be provided to her as evidence of the
