was also assigned to the Secret Service's Counter Assault Team of which he assumed the role of team leader and was later promoted to supervisor; and

WHEREAS, SAIC Sexton began his distinguished career as a field agent in the Chicago Field Office; and

WHEREAS, while in Birmingham, Mr. Sexton served as a member of the Board of Directors for the Birmingham Crime Stoppers Program and as Chairman of the Board in 2011 and 2012; and

WHEREAS, born in Ashland, Kentucky, Mr. Sexton graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Mathematics from the United States Naval Academy in 1984; he served as a Surface Warfare Officer on board the USS South Carolina (CGN 37) in Norfolk, Virginia, and later as an Instructor and Company Officer at Officer Candidate School in Newport, Rhode Island; he is married to the former Laurie E. Weaver, and they have two daughters, Victoria and Katherine; and

WHEREAS, through the years, Mr. Sexton has earned immense respect for his tireless dedication and exceptional abilities; his unwavering commitment to excellence in national security reflects immense honor upon the entire United States of America, and he is truly deserving of special recognition; now therefore,
