8 COMMENDING LEANN BROWN FOR LIFESAVING ACTIONS AND
9 COMMUNITY SERVICE.

11 WHEREAS, highest commendation is herein conveyed to
12 Leann Brown in recognition of saving the life of a heart
13 attack victim by immediately responding to the crisis and
14 providing competent assistance; and

15 WHEREAS, Leann Brown is a highly regarded emergency
16 room nurse at Shelby Baptist Center and was off-duty when the
17 emergency arose, just prior to the beginning of a musical
18 performance at Thompson Middle School, when a middle-aged
19 woman who had come to the event became ill and fell onto the
20 floor; and

21 WHEREAS, along with two other audience members
22 (Robin Anderton, who is also an emergency room nurse at Shelby
23 Baptist Center, and Audrey Kimbrough, the Regional Paramedical
24 Service Operations Manager in Shelby County), Leann Brown
25 undertook the necessary procedures to stabilize the victim

1 until the arrival of the Alabaster Fire Department Medical
2 Team and an ambulance crew; and

3 WHEREAS, as a result of the immediate response of
4 these competent women, motivated by humanitarian instincts and
5 guided by diligent training, the heart attack victim survived,
6 and witnesses to the event have marveled at the happenstance
7 that placed a "trio of angels" at the scene; and

8 WHEREAS, through the years and in all her endeavors,
9 Leann Brown has earned respect for her exceptional abilities
10 and tireless dedication, and she is truly deserving of special
11 recognition for her valiant, lifesaving actions on the evening
12 of February 14, 2013, at Thompson Middle School; now
13 therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
15 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Leann Brown is most highly
16 honored and commended for saving the life of a heart attack
17 victim, and it is directed that a copy of this resolution of
18 tribute be provided to her as evidence of the esteem in which
19 she is held by the people of the State of Alabama.
