8 MOURNING THE DEATH OF MR. L.V. HALL.

10 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we mourn
11 the death of Mr. L.V. Hall of Tuscaloosa, Alabama, on March
12 11, 2013, at the age of 82 years; and

13 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of
14 his loving family and his many friends; and

15 WHEREAS, born on October 30, 1930, he became a foot
16 soldier in the battle for Civil Rights, a political activist,
17 and a compassionate advocate of programs to benefit
18 underprivileged children; and

19 WHEREAS, among his notable community contributions,
20 he was an avid supporter of the Benjamin Barnes YMCA, which
21 inducted him into its Hall of Fame in 2012; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Hall was a member of First African
23 Baptist Church, serving as a member of the Board of Deacons
24 for more than 40 years and in many other capacities; he was a
25 public-service person and a skilled handyman who willingly
26 took on any task when the need arose; and

1 WHEREAS, originally from Greensboro in Hale County,
2 Mr. Hall fell in love with his adopted city; he worked at S.H.
3 Kress Department Store in downtown Tuscaloosa and also
4 operated a shoe shop for several years; he was exceptionally
5 knowledgeable about Tuscaloosa history and was an unofficial
6 ambassador for the city wherever he went; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Hall was a valued member of the
8 community; although his presence will be greatly missed, his
9 legacy will endure and his memory will be cherished in the
10 hearts of those who were fortunate to know him; now therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
12 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the death of Mr. L.V. Hall is
13 recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution is offered in
14 admiration and appreciation of his dedicated service to
15 mankind.
