22 Montevallo, Auburn University, and The University of Alabama;
23 she was a member of Kappa Kappa Gamma Sorority; and

25 husband to Guntersville in 1962; through the years, Mrs.
26 Powers took an active role in the family business, in addition

1 to being an avid tennis and bridge player and winning the
2 ladies golf championship several times at Cherokee Ridge
3 Country Club; and

4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Powers was a devout member of the
5 First United Methodist Church, serving in many capacities; she
6 was committed to helping people and was a member of the
7 American Red Cross disaster team, often assisting at the scene
8 after tornadoes and other storms; and

9 WHEREAS, survivors include her husband of more than
10 52 years, Jack Powers; daughters, Jenny Powers (Neal Light)
11 and Pamela Powers Allen; grandchildren, Chelsee Allen and
12 Andrew Allen; and brother, Dr. Andrew Finlay, Jr.; and

13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Powers was a valued member of the
14 community; although her presence will be greatly missed, her
15 memory will be cherished in the hearts of those who were
16 fortunate to know her; now therefore,
