10 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we mourn
11 the death of Mr. William C. "Bill" Bowling of Hanceville,
12 Alabama, on April 5, 2013, at the age of 85 years; and

13 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of
14 his loving family and his many friends; he was a longtime
15 educator who impacted many young lives as a teacher at both
16 Cullman High School and Wallace State Community College in
17 Hanceville; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Bowling was a highly regarded member of
19 the extended family of the Alabama Legislature, having served
20 from 1978-1994 as a member of the House of Representatives,
21 where he was admired and respected by colleagues in addition
22 to being greatly appreciated by his constituents in the 12th
23 District; he dedicated his career to promoting education, most
24 notably through Wallace State Community College; and

25 WHEREAS, born on September 4, 1927, in Cullman, he
26 was the son of William Louis and Doris Bottcher Bowling; in
27 addition to his contributions to education and the State of

1 Alabama, he served his country with honor and distinction in
2 both the United States Navy and the United States Army; and

3 WHEREAS, in addition to his parents, he was
4 predeceased by his brother, Robert Bowling; and

5 WHEREAS, survivors include his wife, Marie McClendon
6 Bowling; son, Chuck Bowling; daughters, Becky (Ed) Asher and
7 Dianne Holcomb; seven grandchildren, Noah and Nick Bowling,
8 Heather Brand, Cory (Shannon) Holcomb, Anthony, Riley, and
9 Eddie Asher; great-granddaughter, Isabella Brand; and sisters,
10 Dorothy Boerner and Nelle Koons; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Bowling was a valued member of the
12 community; although his presence will be greatly missed, his
13 legacy will endure and his memory will be cherished in the
14 hearts of those who were fortunate to know him; now therefore,

16 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the death of Mr. William C.
