12 will present the colors, and Mayor Tony Kennon of Orange Beach
13 will welcome the participants; and

14 WHEREAS, a flag folding ceremony will be
15 demonstrated by Jennifer Robertson, Community Service Programs
16 Public Issues Chair, and Dr. Barry Booth will be the keynote
17 speaker at the April 12 Patriotic Luncheon; and

18 WHEREAS, the Gulf Shores Women's Club will present a
19 Pinks and Fashion Show at the April 12 Banquet promoting
20 Breast Cancer Awareness, the GFWC Alabama President's Project;

22 WHEREAS, the Jacksonville State University
23 International House Scholarship Recipient, Lara Lubinski of
24 Sweden, will be the keynote speaker at the April 13 breakfast;

2 Scholarship Winner, will be the keynote speaker at the April
3 13 Juniorette Luncheon, when Juniorette awards including the
4 Outstanding Juniorette Award will be distributed; and

5 WHEREAS, Alabama Supreme Court Associate Justice Lyn
6 Stuart will be the keynote speaker, and the past AWFC
7 Presidents will be honored at the April 13 Domestic Violence
8 Banquet; and

9 WHEREAS, also on April 13, the Operations Manager
10 for Ronald McDonald House of Mobile will crown the Pop Tab
11 Queen of the club bringing the most pop tabs for Ronald
12 McDonald House, and Soles4Souls will be presented with all the
13 shoes that clubwomen have brought; and

14 WHEREAS, awards will be given in the Arts,
15 Conservation, Education, Home Life, International Outreach,
16 and Public Issues Community Service Programs to the 54 clubs
17 and more than 1,500 clubwomen of Alabama; and

18 WHEREAS, the AFWC Clubwomen whom the organization
19 lost in 2012 will be honored at a Memorial Breakfast on April
20 14, and Dr. John Borom's slides of birds will be shown; now
