3 MOURNING THE DEATH OF FORMER BRITISH PRIME MINISTER
4 MARGARET THATCHER.

6 WHEREAS, it is with an overwhelming sense of loss
7 that we mourn the death of former British Prime Minister
8 Margaret Thatcher on April 8, 2013, at the age of 87 years;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, Baroness Thatcher was the first female
11 Prime Minister of Britain, serving between 1979-1990, and is
12 credited with not only transforming her country's economy but
13 actually changing the world; and

14 WHEREAS, she was a loyal ally of America in the
15 global war against Soviet aggression and Communism; and

16 WHEREAS, the strength of her personality was
17 legendary, and her opinions, which were delivered succinctly
18 and forcibly, inevitably clarified complex matters and served
19 as touchstones in disputes; and

20 WHEREAS, among her notable accomplishments, she
21 provided the crucial leadership for Britain's military victory
22 in the Falklands War in 1982; and

23 WHEREAS, internationally known as The Iron Lady, she
24 was always immaculately coiffed and attired, even bejeweled,
25 yet her femininity in no way diminished the power of her

1 presence; she was a woman who made a difference, perhaps more
2 than any other world leader in the 20th Century; now
3 therefore,

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
5 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the death of former Prime
6 Minister Margaret Thatcher is recorded with deep sadness, and
7 this resolution is offered in highest tribute to her life
8 along with heartfelt sympathy to the British people, whose
9 grief is shared by the people of the State of Alabama.
