20 Forest Lake Baptist Church, past member of the Tuscaloosa
21 County Democratic Committee, and a volunteer in many local,
22 state, and federal political campaigns; and

23 WHEREAS, most recently, she volunteered at Wings of
24 Grace, a service organization formed by Forest Lake Baptist
25 Church after the devastating tornado outbreak of April 2011;
26 she was an avid gardener, spending many hours grooming her

1 lawn and flower garden, and also took pleasure in patrolling
2 the Forest Lake neighborhood; and

3 WHEREAS, she was predeceased by her husband of 27
4 years, Boyce Dayton Thornton, Sr.; parents, Walter and Savilla
5 Sherer Brown; two brothers; and a sister; and

6 WHEREAS, survivors include her son, Boyce Dayton
7 Thornton, Jr.; and numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives,
8 and friends; and

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thornton was a valued member of the
10 community; although her presence will be greatly missed, her
11 memory will be cherished in the hearts of those who were
12 fortunate to know her; now therefore,

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
