13 participating in a china painting class, creating original
14 keepsakes; she is also greatly admired for her gardening
15 skills, and her beautiful flowers are well-known and
16 appreciated throughout the Opp area; and

17 WHEREAS, Mrs. Boothe is a devout member of the First
18 Baptist Church in Opp, where she teaches a Sunday School Class
19 and helps with Vacation Bible School, and she also volunteers
20 her time to Mizell Memorial Hospital as a member of the
21 Auxiliary Committee; and

22 WHEREAS, the widow of J.C. Boothe, she has two sons,
23 Representative Alan C. (Anne) Boothe and Gene (Peb) Boothe;
24 five grandchildren, Jason Boothe, Kevin Boothe, April Boothe
