NAMING A PORTION OF UNITED STATES HIGHWAY 90 IN
MOBILE COUNTY THE ARMY PFC WILBERT E. WAXTON AND MARINE CORPS
PFC DAVID N. LAFFERTY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, Army PFC Wilbert E. Waxton and Marine Corps
PFC David N. Lafferty, who were killed in the line of duty in
the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS, they were in the war in Vietnam, bloodied,
and outside the band of brothers who served, many people have
never seen what they were fighting against and know what they
were fighting for; and

WHEREAS, the journalists, college students, and
peace activists never realized the damage they were doing, or
that all of them had freedoms because of what warriors, who
paid the price, did to protect them; and

WHEREAS, because of them we felt the defense of
freedom, our domestic tranquility, and our way of life here in
America was worthy of our fight; and

Whereas, it is fitting and proper for us to honor
Army PFC Wilbert E. Waxton and Marine Corps PFC David N.

1 Lafferty, who made the ultimate sacrifice for our country in
2 Vietnam; now therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
4 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we direct the Mobile County
5 Commission to select a portion of United States Highway 90, in
6 Mobile County, to be named the Army PFC Wilbert E. Waxton and
7 Marine Corps PFC David N. Lafferty in honor of their service
8 to our state and country.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the appropriate
10 officials are requested to place and maintain signs or markers
11 as provided in this resolution.
