1 WHEREAS, upon graduation, he was selected by Bishop
2 Charles Duval to come to the Diocese of the Central Gulf Coast
3 in 1983, where he first served at St. James Church in
4 Fairhope, Alabama, as the assistant priest until 1985; and

5 WHEREAS, currently, Reverend Brown serves as the
6 dedicated priest of three congregations: St. Michael's
7 Episcopal Church in Chickasaw, St. Matthew's Episcopal Church
8 in Mobile, and St. Thomas' Episcopal Church in Citronelle; he
9 also serves the residents of Murray House Assisted Living
10 Center; and

11 WHEREAS, indeed, Reverend Brown continues to provide
12 the members of his congregation with opportunities to grow in
13 Christian service, and his qualities of leadership and
14 pastoral experience have greatly strengthened his ministry;

17 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That Reverend Dennis Brown is
