16 in Centre, having graduated from Cherokee County High School
17 and Murdock's International Cotton School in Memphis,

20 Community in Cherokee County, where his family had farmed and
21 operated a cotton merchant business for more than 100 years;

23 WHEREAS, affectionately known as "Fishhook," he was
24 active in the community, serving on several local boards, and
25 was admired for his skills as a magician and trickster; and

26 WHEREAS, he was also a veteran who served with honor
27 and distinction in the United States Army; and

1 WHEREAS, survivors include his wife of 56 years,
2 Geraldine Steele Jordan; daughter, Freida Jordan (Nick)
3 McMichen; grandchildren, Mindy Geraldine McMichen and Matthew
4 George McMichen; and several nieces and nephews; he was
5 predeceased by his brother, Tom Brock Jordan; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Jordan was a valued member of the
7 community; although his presence will be greatly missed, his
8 memory will be cherished in the hearts of those who were
9 fortunate to know him; now therefore,
