11 WHEREAS, we note the death of former Alabama Senator
12 Tommy Ed Roberts of Hartselle, Alabama, with deep sadness and
13 regret; his immeasurable life of 73 years is commended and
14 celebrated with great thanksgiving; and

15 WHEREAS, the passing of Mr. Roberts leaves a void in
16 the lives of his loving family, many friends, and the entire
17 community, where he was highly regarded; and

18 WHEREAS, born October 19, 1940, in Morgan County, he
19 was the son of Luther E. Roberts and Katherine Hewlett
20 Roberts; he joined First United Methodist Church, of which he
21 has been a lifetime member, as a boy, when his grandfather,
22 Reverend Roy Hewlett, served as minister; and

23 WHEREAS, early in his career, he and his family
24 owned and operated Roberts' Men's Wear in Decatur; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Roberts was first elected to the House
26 of Representatives in 1974; he served two terms before taking

1 a 12-year hiatus; he was elected again in 1994 and served
2 three more terms; and

3 WHEREAS, a dedicated and effective public servant,
4 Mr. Roberts served with exceptional capability and worked
5 tirelessly to improve the lives of all Alabamians; and

6 WHEREAS, survivors include his beloved and devoted
7 wife of 55 years, Pat Hogan Roberts; his son and
8 daughter-in-law, Andy and Cindy Roberts; his daughter and
9 son-in-law, Stacey Roberts Wade and Dr. Freddie Wade;
10 stepmother, Mable Roberts; and his sister and brother-in-law,
11 Edna Carol Weeks and Jerry Weeks; and six grandchildren; and

12 WHEREAS, through the years, Senator Roberts earned
13 immense respect for his tireless dedication and exceptional
14 abilities; and

15 WHEREAS, Senator Roberts was a valued member of the
16 community; although his presence is greatly missed, his memory
17 is cherished in the hearts and minds of all those who were
18 fortunate enough to know him; now therefore,
