4 THE FRED FRICKIE BASEBALL FIELD.

6 WHEREAS, Fred Frickie was inducted into the Alabama
7 Community College Athletic Hall of Fame Class of 2006, which
8 recognizes athletics as an integral and extremely important
9 part of learning teamwork, discipline, and good sportsmanship,
10 and the many people responsible for instilling these ideals
11 and values in not only themselves, but also the youth of
12 today; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Frickie was the college's baseball
14 coach for 28 years before retiring in 1995; his winning record
15 of 668 victories ranked him high among conference coaches; he
16 was listed in the top 25 of the nation's two-year baseball
17 coaches; and his teams posted a winning percentage of .618;

19 WHEREAS, during his tenure at Calhoun Community
20 College, six of his teams won the Alabama State Championship;
21 six of his players were honored as All-Americans; and several
22 of his players advanced to the Major Leagues, including Jorge
23 Posada and former Calhoun Baseball Coach Gary Redus; and

24 WHEREAS, the people of Alabama are proud to
25 recognize and honor Fred Frickie, who possesses the skill and

1 determination to succeed in his efforts and who touched the
2 lives of countless youth in the lessons for life and success;
3 now therefore,

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
5 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition and gratitude
6 for outstanding contributions to athletics, we declare that
7 the Calhoun Community College baseball field is named the Fred
8 Frickie Baseball Field.
