11 the death of Mr. Charles Edward Little of Satsuma, Alabama, on
12 March 7, 2014, at the age of 77 years; and

13 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of
14 his loving family and his many friends; he was a highly
15 regarded businessman and civic leader; and

16 WHEREAS, born on June 2, 1936, in Pontotoc,
17 Mississippi, Mr. Little served as a Satsuma City Councilman
18 from 1968 to 1980 and Mayor from 1980 to 1996; he loved
19 working with all the council members and the people of
20 Satsuma; and

21 WHEREAS, in 1964, he began selling automobiles at
22 Little's Pure Oil Station and later moved down the highway to
23 the present location of Little's Auto Sales; he was very
24 active in the Alabama Independent Auto Dealers Association,
25 serving as president in 1995; among his recognitions, he was
26 named Quality Dealer in 1994; and

1 WHEREAS, devoted to family and faith, Mr. Little was
2 an active member of First Baptist Church Satsuma, serving as a
3 deacon and on many committees; and

4 WHEREAS, he was predeceased by his father, A.C.
5 Little; mother, Loyce Little; and daughter, Regina Lynn
6 Little; and

7 WHEREAS, survivors include his wife of 50 years,
8 Roma Jean Little; sons, Randy (Diane) Little and Dale (Kelly)
9 Little; grandchildren, Ryan (Kelly), Hannah, Brinkley and
10 Hadley; great grandson, Aidan; sisters, Jo Bost and Jimmy
11 (Gerald) Gatlin; and many other relatives; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Little was a valued member of the
13 community; although his presence will be missed, his memory
14 will be cherished in the hearts of those who were fortunate to
15 know him; now therefore,
