3 mother-in-law, Annette Bishop; and special sister, Jan Rhodes,
4 who was the mother of her daughter-in-law; and

6 Bishop; son, Brant Bishop; daughter-in-law, Shannon Bishop;
7 her cherished grandsons, William and Clay Bishop; sister,
